# **WOOFER WIRING CONFIGURATIONS**

Use the diagrams below to determine which amplifier is best compatible with your subwoofers, and to determine the best way to wire your subwoofers to your amplifier.

### **ONE 2Ω SVC WOOFER**

Wiring one SVC sub to an amp is the most basic type of wiring. The best option is to always match the exact impedance of the sub to the exact impedance the amp is stable at. For a SVC 2-ohm sub, we recommend that you wire it to a 2-ohm stable mono amp. A 1-ohm stable mono amp will work just fine as well. Just be sure to match the power of the amplifier to the power of the subwoofer.

# WIRED TO A 2-OHM OR 1-OHM STABLE MONO AMPLIFIER + 2Ω + 2Ω @ amp - 2Ω -

### TWO 2Ω SVC WOOFERS

You can either run this set-up in parallel to a 1-ohm mono amp or in series to a 4-ohm amp. One other option is to use a 2-ohm stable 2-channel amp and run one sub per channel.
